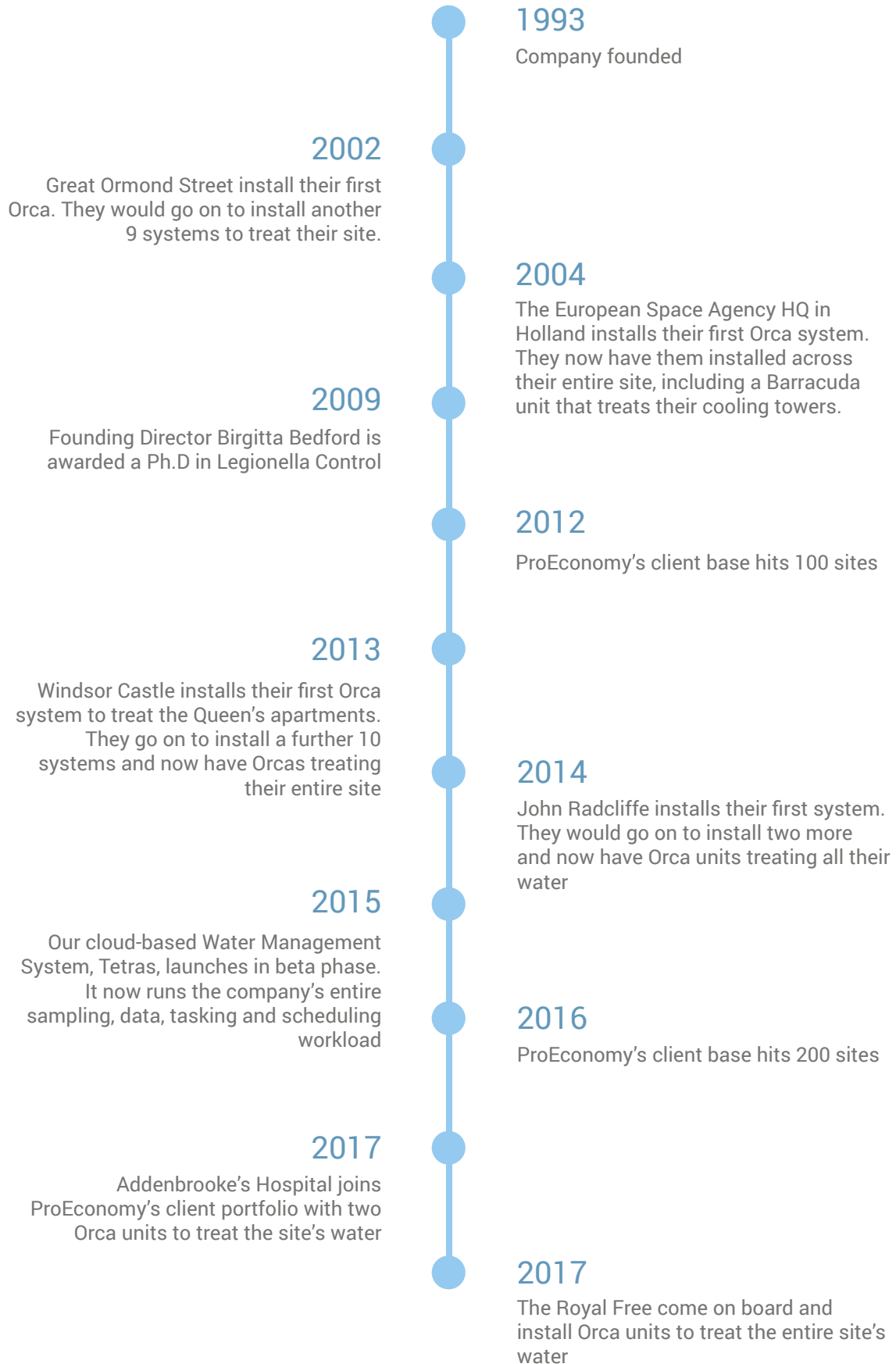












History

1993	Company founded
